Dear Valued Customer,

On April 1, 2019, the Federal Government implemented a national carbon tax on each tonne of emissions from fossil fuels in an attempt to reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

As a result of this tax, a new carbon surcharge was applied on each invoice since April 1, 2019. The government will be increasing the national carbon tax effective April 1, 2022. Below outlines the 2021 rate as well as the planned 2022 increase:

Carbon surcharge scale: Applies on the “freight” charge only
